# THE AIR NAVIGATION REGULATIONS, AMENDMENT TO AVIATION FEES The new revised charges are effective from 1 July 2000.

# GEN 4. CHARGES FOR AERODROMES AND AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES GEN 4.1 AERODROME CHARGES

# 1. Landing of aircraft

1.1 Maximum permissible take-off weight allowed as specified under the regulations of the State in which the aircraft is registered.

# 1.2 Landing charges

A series of landings made within one hour in the course of training shall be charged as one landing at the standard rate.

#### Rules

- 1.2.1 These fees shall apply to aircraft paying annually or monthly.
- 1.2.2 No abatement of landing shall be made.

# Parking, hangarage and long – term storage of aircraft

## 2.1 Parking of aircraft

The first 6 hours are free. After six hours and within a period of 24 hours, or part thereof, fees will be charged as below:

#### 3. Passenger service

Each passenger departing to a foreign country at an International aerodrome is charged US\$40 while on domestic flight, Uganda Shs 3000. This charge is collected by the operator/owner on behalf of Civil Aviation Authority and is included on the passenger fare.

#### 4. Aviation Security Charge

a) Each departing international and regional passenger 2 years of age and over will be required to pay US\$10 charged on the air ticket.

 Each departing domestic passenger 2 years of age and over, will be required to pay UGX 2000/= charged on the air ticket.

#### 6. Other Charges

#### 6.1 Lighting Charge

50% of the single day landing charge for aircraft landing or take-off between 1600hrs and 0400hrs UTC

# 6.2 Aerobridge Charge

For all aircraft, charge for the first 3 hours is USD \$60, and charge per hour or part thereof after the first 3 hours is \$60

#### Exemptions and reductions

#### 7.1 Exemptions

- (a) Passengers in direct transit
- (b) Children under 2 years
- (c) Crew members of the aircraft involved

- (d) State aircraft owned by the Government of Uganda
- (e) Aircraft forced to return to the aerodrome of departure for reasons of safety, if no intermediate landing is made.
- (f) Aircraft landing solely for customs, health and immigration or traffic control purposes provided that;
  - (i) No passengers cargo and mail are disembarked and no fuel uplifted;
  - (ii) The exemption is claimed at the time of landing.
- (g) Test flights during normal hours subject to prior notification (excluding aircraft engaged in flights for hire or reward)
- (h) Aircraft engaged in search and rescue operations.
- On scheduled operations, no parking charge if time on ground is part of the approved schedule.
- (j) Parking fee exemptions same as for landing.
- (k) When a helicopter or an aircraft not exceeding 2200 kg weight and which is operated by an authorized flying club or is privately owned and is used solely for private business purposes not being for hire or reward, makes a single landing at any Civil Aviation aerodrome, except Entebbe, the fees shall be one half of the standard landing.

7.4 Cargo

Cargo charges are based on the gross weight of the cargo being loaded or unloaded. The charge is collected by the airline operator on behalf of the Civil Aviation Authority.

# 8. Methods of payment

All non-scheduled flights by aircraft not registered in Uganda and landing at Entebbe Airport must pay all charges to the duty Revenue Officer before departure of the aircraft.

#### GEN 4.2 AIR NAVIGATION SERVICES CHARGES

#### Approach control

Charges for approach control are included in air navigation charges.

# Cost basis for air navigation services and exemptions/reductions

Cost basis for air navigation services is under review.

#### Exemptions/Reductions

The following categories of flights shall be exempted from payment of air navigation facility charges.

- State aircraft owned or operated by the Government of Uganda
- (b) Aircraft forced to return to the aerodrome of departure for reasons of safety, if no immediate landing is made.
- (c) Test flights subject to prior notification.
- (d) Aircraft making flights for the purposes as the Managing Director of Civil Aviation Authority may approve.
- (e) Aircraft owned by the Civil Aviation Authority.

(f) Uganda Military Aircraft.

#### 4. Methods of payment

The owner and leaser of an aircraft are jointly and severally responsible for payment of the charge. The billing and collection of air navigation facility charges is carried out by IATA on behalf of Civil Aviation Authority. Notification of the charges will be made monthly by forwarding an invoice.

#### 5. Other Additional Information

#### General

- (a) All foreign aircraft operators will pay in foreign convertible currencies in cash or travelers cheques.
- (b) Local aircraft operators may pay the equivalent in Uganda currency.
- (c) International overflights, international regular charter flights, and flights of Uganda based operators will receive normal statements and invoices to pay the charges in accordance with (a) and (b) above.
- (d) Occasional international charter flights and non-schedule flights will pay at Entebbe Airport on first landing and take-off.
- (e) Civil Aviation Authority Accounts staff collecting the charges are based at the Aerodrome AIS Unit (Briefing Office) at Entebbe International Airport.

"Normal hours" means the hours from 0600 hours to 1830 hours local standard time.

"Owner" means the registered owner or where the aircraft is operated for hire or reward by some person other than the registered owner, that person.

"Flight" in the FIR means:

A flight into, out of, within (aerodrome of departure to aerodrome of destination) or through its airspace.
