- The modification of the Passenger Terminal to provide modern and expansive Arrival and Departure areas and the entire passenger Terminal.

Finally, in an effort to improve efficiency, Uganda recently attained the prestigious ISO 9001:2015 Quality Management System certification from the United Kingdom Accreditation service ahead of the December 2019

deadline set for at least 60% of the African states to have attained the same. I encourage the other members of the AFI Region to work towards this accreditation.
