I am pleased to welcome you all to Uganda Civil Aviation Authority (UCAA). It is with great pleasure that we are receiving a donation of 2,550 bottles of sanitizers from Modern Distillers Ltd today. - There are ongoing efforts to create more space in the waiting lounges by removing the partitions to create open lounges that accord more space for social distancing.
