INTERIM REGULATORY DIRECTIVE (IRD)

A Directive by the UCAA on 07-09-2023

CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION AND DE-REGISTRATION

This Interim Regulatory Directive is issued for regulatory purposes pursuant to Section 15 (k) of the Civil Aviation Authority Act Cap. 354 as amended.

Under the powers conferred by Section 15 (k) of the Civil Aviation Authority Act as amended, the Director General of Uganda Civil Aviation Authority hereby issued this directive to clarify ambiguity in Parts III, IV, V, VI, VII, and subsequent regulations; 3,12(2,5,7,8 and 12),13,20,22(1) and Schedules 3 and 5 of the Civil Aviation (Aircraft Nationality and Registration Marks) Regulations, 2022, Statutory Instrument 76 dated 12th August 2022 as follows:

The cited regulation contains the term "Common Mark" which is used in registering aircraft of an international operating agency other than on a national basis. The Uganda Nationality Marks are 5X- followed by the registration marks of the Aircraft which consists of 3 Roman capital letters. This anomaly was noted by the Authority following the promulgation of the Regulations thus prompting the Director General to issue this interim regulatory directive requiring holders of Certificates of Registration and De-registration issued under the provisions of the Statutory Instrument 76, to surrender the said certificates to the Authority immediately for exchange with the re-issued/corrected certificates at no cost.
